School Lunches

From September lunch will continue to be provided by Chartwells at the cost of £2.15 per day and must be booked in advance through ParentPay. Remember, all KS1 and Reception children are eligible for a free hot lunch. Although pupils in these age groups will receive a free school meal, it is still very important that free meals are applied for if you are in receipt of certain benefits. By doing so the school receives extra money for your child called Pupil Premium Funding Grant. This extra money will be used to directly support your child's education and helps to pay for things like extra 1:1 and small group tuition and trips.

If you believe that you may be eligible, which ever year group your child is in, you can apply quickly and easily by visiting the local authority website:- www.kent.gov.uk/education-and-children/schools/free-school-meals.

There are still some outstanding debts on ParentPay, particularly for School Dinners and Extended Day Clubs. It would be most helpful if you could check your account and clear anything outstanding to the end of term. This will help our accounting and enable us to start with a clean slate in September.
